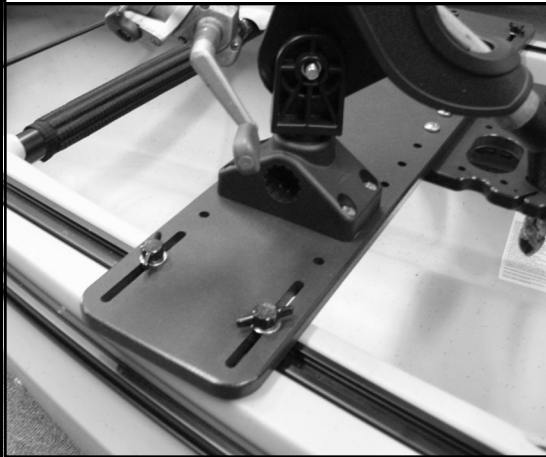


Mad Frog Gear Commander Low

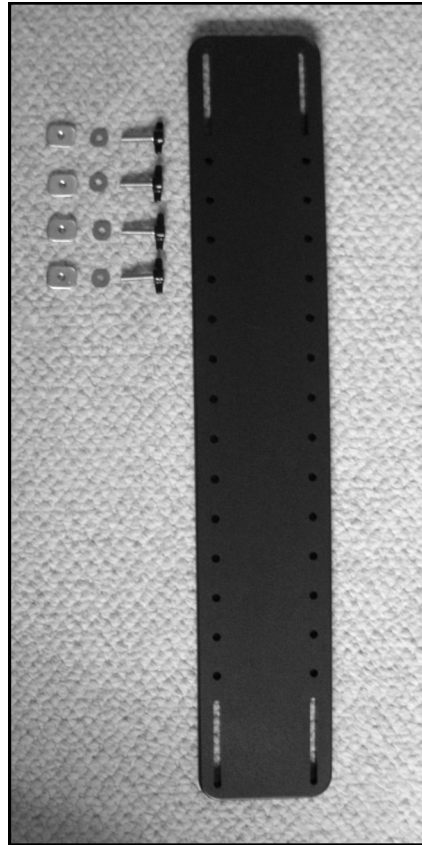


The Commander Low was designed to attach directly onto the deck rails of the Wilderness Systems Commander.

It provides you with additional space to mount accessories, without having to drill any extra holes in your kayak.

Great for mounting:

- Rod Holders
 - Fishfinders
 - Cameras
 - GPS Units
 - Safety Gear
- the possibilities are endless.



Included in the kit:

- (1) Starlight Dashboard
- (4) Washers
- (4) 1/4-20 x 1 1/8" Thumb Screws
- (4) Brass Plates

Instructions:

- 1) Slide the brass plates into the tracks on your Commander.
- 2) Run the 1/4x20x1 1/8" Thumb screws through the four washers .

3) Then one at a time, run the Thumb screws (with washers) through the slots on each end of the Dashboard and line them up with one of the brass plates in the track and screw it part way down.

4) Once all four Thumb screws have been started, slide the board up or down the track until it is in the desired position. Keep in mind you don't want it to close to you, as it could interfere with your paddle stroke.

5) Tighten the Thumb screw to secure the unit.



6) To remove unit simply loosen Thumb screws and slide the brass plates off the open end of the tracks.

The Commander Dashboard has been pre-drilled with a series of holes spaced to match the hole pattern of Scotty Rod Holder bases. If you are looking to mount other products on your dashboard simply locate them on an open area of the board and drill your own holes, Starlight is easy to drill through.
